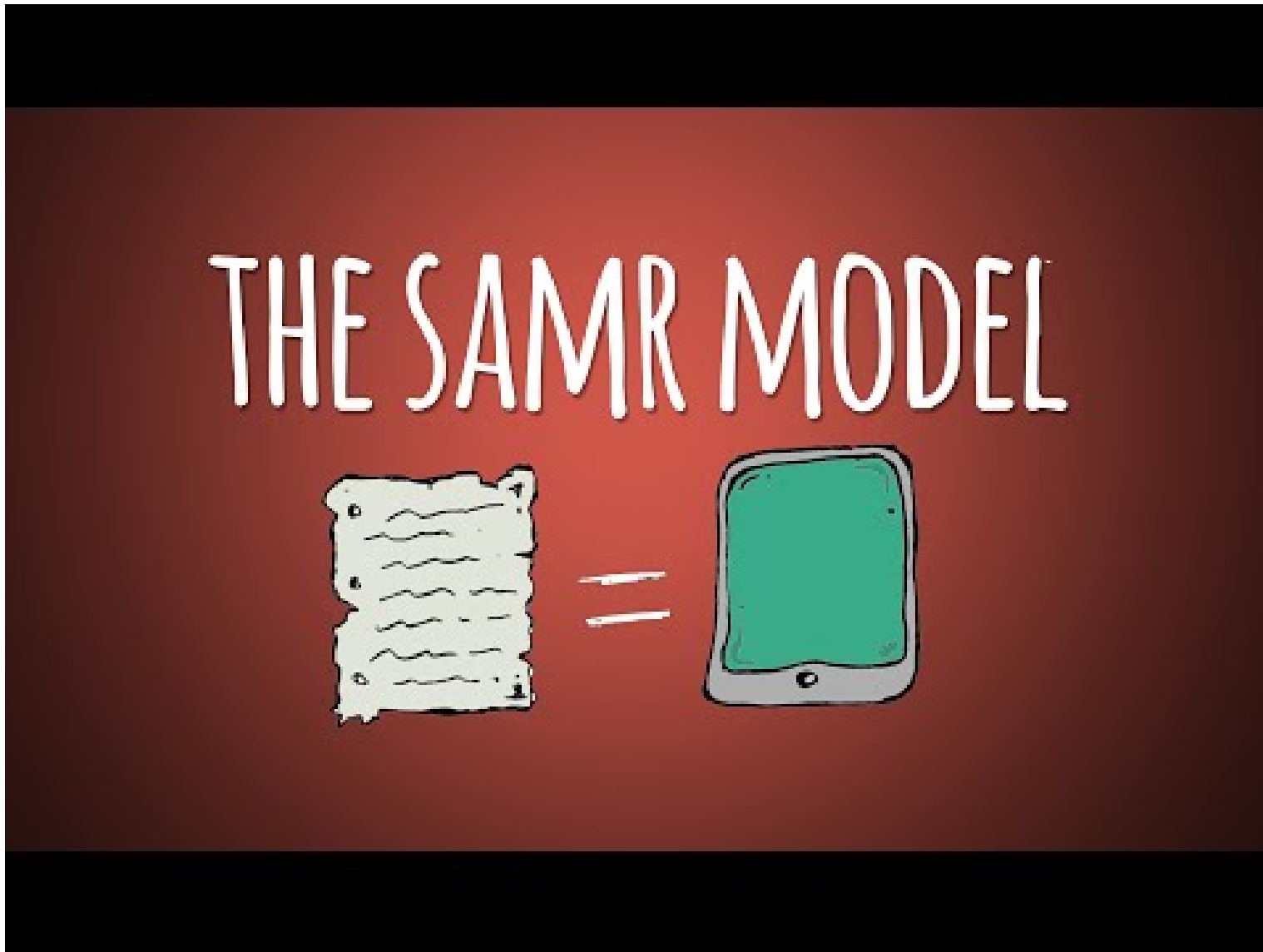

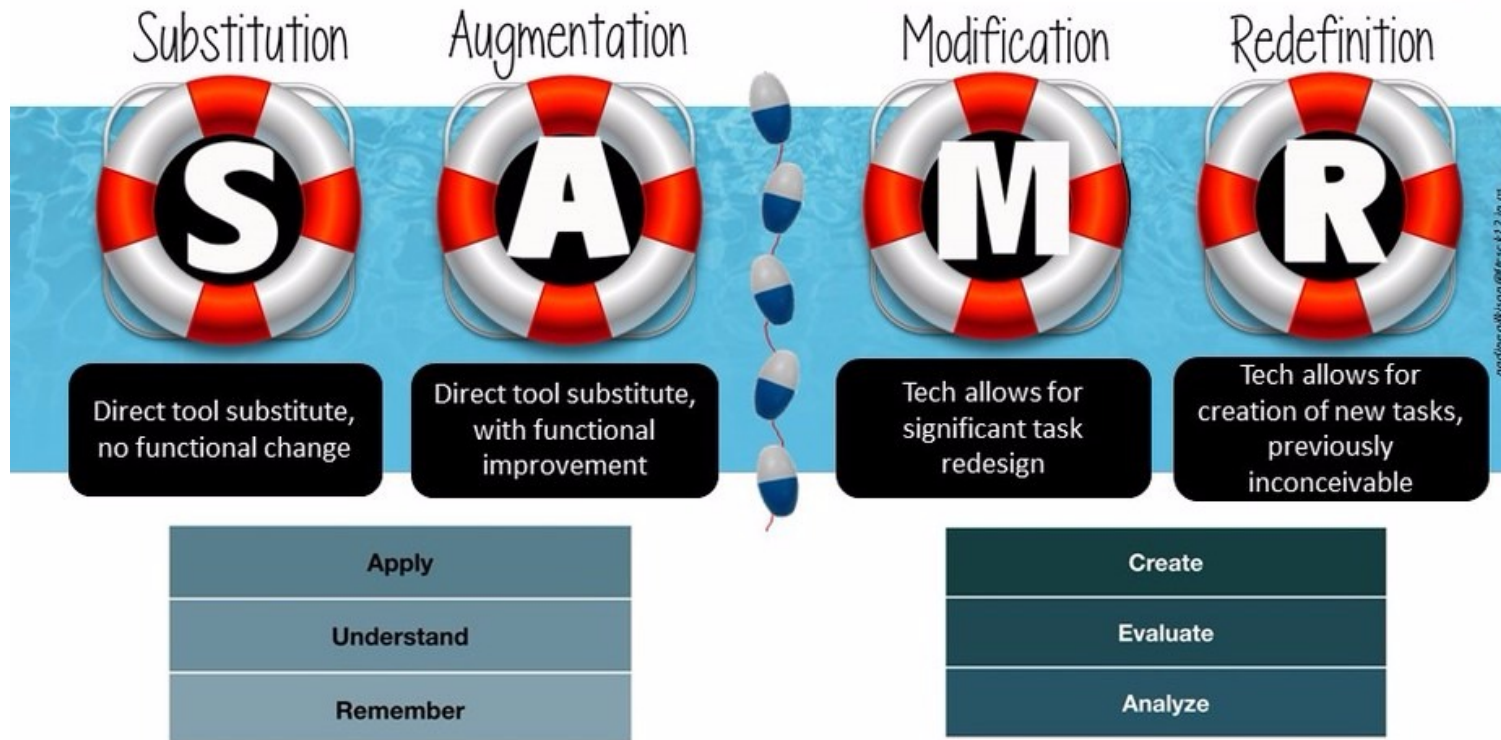


What is Tech Integration in the classroom?

Break-down of SAMR

Teacher creates, models technology integrated lessons for **students**.

Teacher still creates, models technology integrated lessons at this level, but **STUDENTS** become active creators applying their DOK through the use of technology.

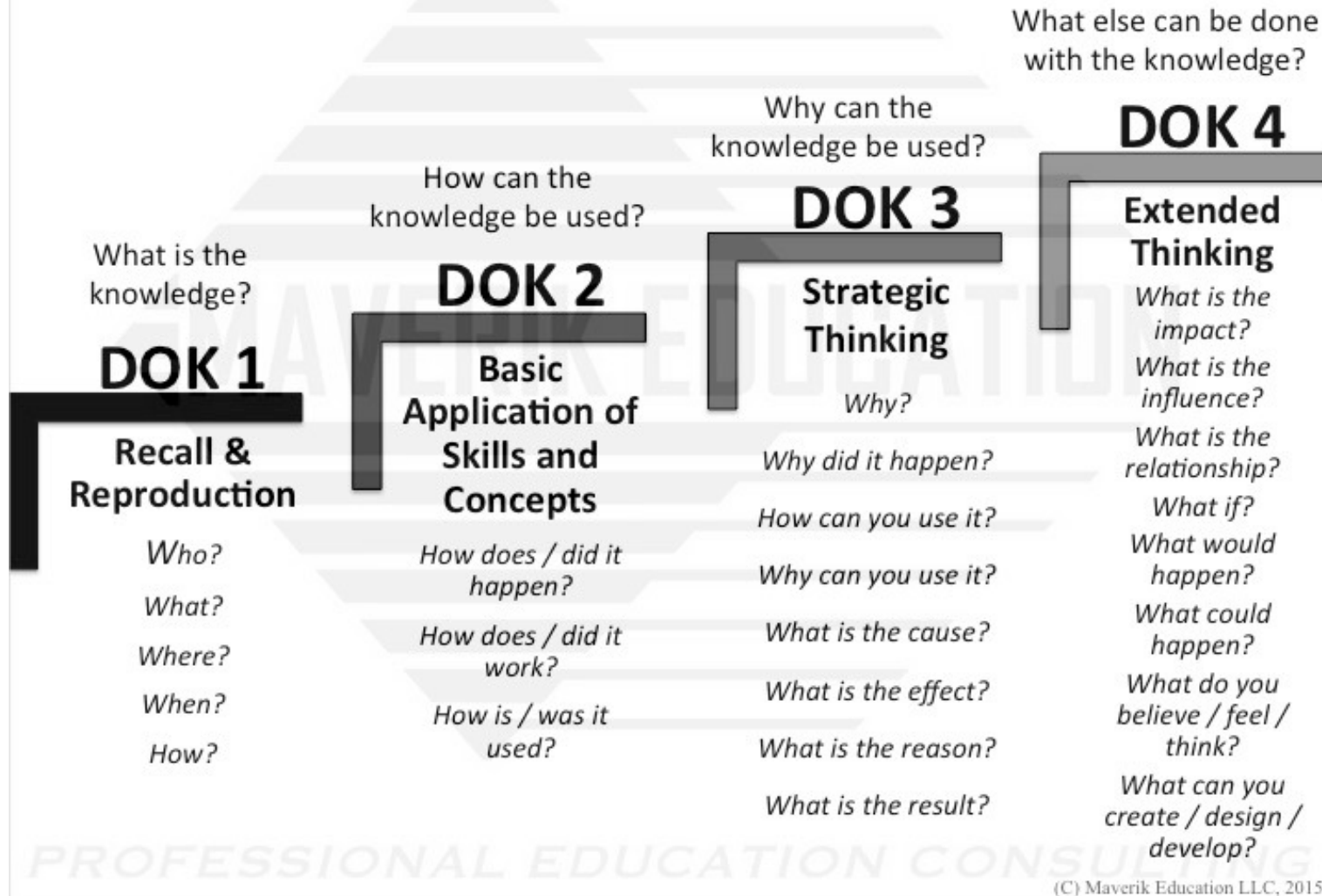

Depth of Knowledge is...

How extensively students are to express and share their knowledge.

Factual knowledge (What needs to be known?)

Procedural knowledge (How can it be used?)

Strategic knowledge (Why can it be used to get a desired result?)

Extended knowledge (What else can be done with the information and how could it be used?)



Depth of Knowledge is NOT...

It's NOT what the student is expected to do or demonstrate but rather the scenario or the situation in which students express and share their learning.

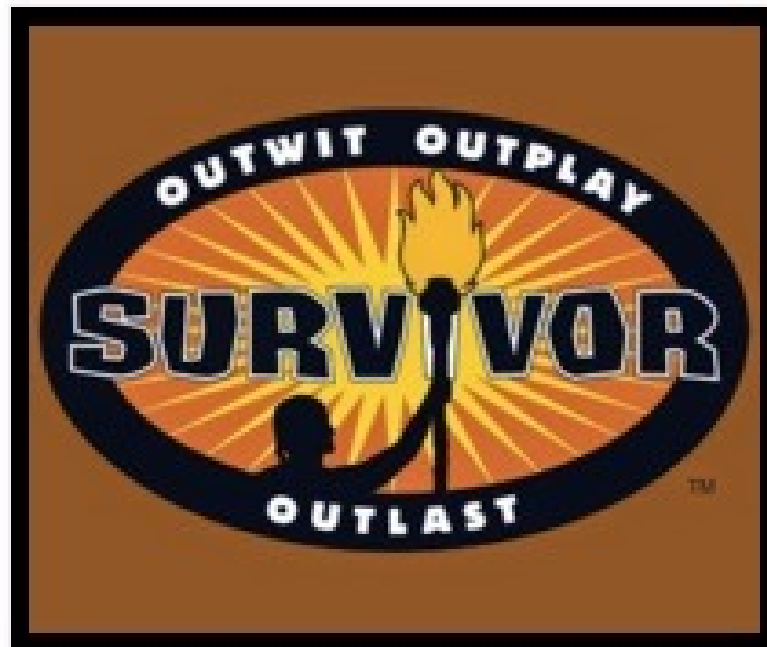
